Probably the greatest question of all time is found in Mark 16:3. The question is: "Who will roll away the stone?"

Mark 16:3 "And they said among themselves, "Who will roll away the stone from the door of the tomb for us?"

John 11:42 "And I know that You always hear Me, but because of the people who are standing by I said this, that they may believe that You sent Me."

John 11:25 "Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live."

There is a big difference between doing resurrections and, being the Resurrection.

Romans 10:9 "If you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved."
