Revelation 4:11 "Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created."

Because God created us for His pleasure then we should make sure He enjoys what He has created. What if we allowed God to, "fulfill all the good pleasure of His goodness."

2 Thessalonians 1:11 "Therefore we also pray always for you that our God would count you worthy of this calling, and fulfill all the good pleasure of His goodness and the work of faith with power."

Philippians 2:13 "For it is God who works in you both to will and to do for His good pleasure."

Romans 12:1 "I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service."

Another beautiful part of this is that as we allow God to help Himself to us, He begins to share with us all the mystery of His will. What a joy it is when God begins to share with us all His secrets.

Ephesians 1:9 "Having made known to us the mystery of His will, according to His good pleasure which He purposed in Himself,"

Mark 4:22 (Amplified Bible) [Things are hidden temporarily only as a means to revelation.] For there is nothing hidden except to be revealed, nor is anything [temporarily] kept secret except in order that it may be made known.

Ephesians 1:4-5 Just as He chose us in Him (Jesus) before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love, having predestined us to adoption as sons by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will."

Luke 12:32 "Do not fear, little flock, for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom."
