Dear Friends in Christ.

Praise the Name of Jesus Who is, the Way, the Truth and the Life.

What a wonderful time to be alive and to see the hand of God moving over the earth. For years now we have been praying; "Your Kingdom come, Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven." Now we are seeing it come to pass as God works His will among us. God is constantly raising us to a higher realm of faith as He reveals Himself and His will to us. The only way I can keep up is to see everything from His perspective and pray accordingly. This seems to be constantly changing as I see His will more clearly by the Holy Spirit guiding me into all truth.
