Praise the Name of Jesus Who is the Manifestation of the Father.

1 Timothy 3:16 "And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: <u>God was</u> <u>manifested in the flesh</u>, Justified in the Spirit, Seen by angels, Preached among the Gentiles, Believed on in the world, Received up in glory."

The term manifest is about the interaction of the Spiritual and the natural realm. It is brought about by and through the faith of God. By faith God brings things from the unseen realm into the visible realm.

Hebrews 11:1 "Now faith is the <u>substance</u> of things hoped for, the <u>evidence of things not seen."</u>
