All praise to our Father Who is Almighty God!

We have so many questions and we find all the answers in His Word. Who is this Father who has given us birth? Let us look at Hebrews 11:6 for a part of the answer.

Hebrews 11:6 "But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that <u>He is</u>, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him." God does not exist as we know existence. God created all that exists but He Himself is greater than all creation.

Revelation 4:11 "You are worthy, O Lord, To receive glory and honor and power; For You created all things, And by Your will they exist and were created."

Luke 21:33 "Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by no means pass away."

When we speak to God we say YOU ARE, and when we speak to each other about Him we say HE IS. So, I AM, YOU ARE, and HE IS, are all the same statement- just depending on who is saying it. The writer of Hebrews says, He who comes to God must believe that HE IS. I believe HE IS the Great I AM. Father, I believe YOU ARE who you say YOU ARE.

Now, once we have this Faith established in our hearts, we find that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

Psalms 9:10 "And those who know Your name will put their trust in You; For You, LORD, have not forsaken those who seek You."

Exodus 6:6 "Therefore say to the children of Israel: 'Lam the LORD; I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, I will rescue you from their bondage, and I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great judgments."

Psalms 27:8 "When You said, "Seek My face," My heart said to You, "Your face, LORD, I will seek."

What an wonderful promise; If you seek you will find. It will definitely happen.

Proverbs 8:17 "I love those who love me, And those who seek me diligently will find me."

Revelation 4:8 "The four living creatures, each having six wings, were full of eyes around and within. And they do not rest day or night, saying: "Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, Who was and is and is to come!"
